Located in Buenos Aires' San Telmo district (known for its galleries, restaurants, and nightlife), the newly opened **Moreno Hotel** wears its vintage roots well. A 1920s Art Deco building designed by German/Hungarian architect Johannes Kronfuss provides atmosphere with high ceilings accented with preserved stained glass crafted by Gustav van Treeck. In each of the 39 suites, deco mingles with modern design as crisp furnishings juxtapose heavy leather chairs and subdued color schemes. Brussels
SMOOTH LANDING

Headquarters to NATO, Brussels is seeing a bit of international relations in its culinary scene. Six-month-old **Parachute Parc** is run by a Belgian chef who embraces the Spanish tradition of tapas to high-light classic French dishes. His menu changes regularly: on a recent visit, there was a small portion of foie gras with figs, just the right amount of extremely rare venison, and four ravioli bursting with langoustine. Cork, Ireland
LUXE OF THE IRISH

Capella Hotels & Resorts opens its first property in Ireland this August. **Castlemartyr** is a 17th-century manor house in Cork once owned by the Knights Templar and the Third Earl of Cork (whose tomb is on the grounds). Besides a spa and fitness center, the 220-acre estate includes the ruins of a thousand-year-old castle.
